All full-time and part-time employees receive nine paid holidays, including a Diversity Day (also known as a floating holiday) after 30 days of service. The paid holidays in 2022 are as follows.

New Year's Day	Friday, January 1
Epiphany	Thursday, January 6
Good Friday	Friday, April 15
Easter Sunday	Sunday, April 17
Mother's Day	Sunday, May 8
Father's Day	Sunday, June 19
Thanksgiving	Thursday, November 24
Christmas Day	Sunday, December 25
Diversity Day	Determined by Employee

Paid Holidays

- Employees who work on a holiday can take their paid holiday up to 60 days after the actual holiday with supervisor approval.
- Full-time employees receive eight hours pay and part-time employees receive four hours pay for each holiday.
- Employees who work on Good Friday and/or Easter will receive time and one-half for hours worked.
- Casual, seasonal, and temporary employees do not qualify for holiday pay and Diversity Day pay.
- To qualify for holiday pay, employees must work their scheduled day before and after the holiday. If an employee is sick on their scheduled day before or after the holiday, a doctor's note is required when returning to work in order to be paid.
- Holidays cannot be entered while an employee is on a leave of absence.
- Election Day is not a paid Luxottica Holiday. Employees may use their Diversity Day to take paid time off on that day.

Diversity Day

- Diversity Days are granted based upon an employee's status as of January 1, 2022. For example, if an employee is full-time on January 1, they will be granted eight hours of pay. If an employee is part-time on January 1, they will be granted four hours of pay.
- The Diversity Day, intended as floating holiday, may be used anytime throughout the year and does not carry over.
- A Diversity Day can be used during the waiting period of a leave of absence.
