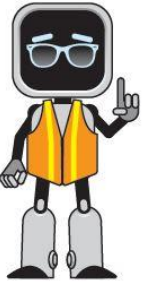


BRITZ HAND SANITIZER



During the height of COVID, Britz was one brand of hand sanitizers provided by Luxottica for employees and customers to use. In July 2020, the FDA recalled certain batches of this brand of hand sanitizer, but Luxottica determined that none of the batches purchased for our company were recalled. Luxottica voluntarily tested our batches and determined it was not acceptable for use as a hand sanitizer but could be used as a surface cleaner.



- If you continue to have Britz in stock, make sure all remaining bottles are labeled **“FOR USE AS A SURFACE CLEANER ONLY.”**
- If you are using the Britz bottle as a pump bottle for a different type of hand sanitizer, you must clearly relabel the bottle to accurately state what type of hand sanitizer is in the bottle. Ex. Apply a large sticker over the “Britz” label with **“STAR SAN HAND SANITIZER”**.

- If you have multiple bottles of Britz in stock and are unable to use it as a surface cleaner, you may request disposal assistance through the Store Maintenance Portal by using the below selections:

- Area – Back Room
- Problem Type – Health and Safety
- Equipment – Consumer Cleaners recycling
- Program Code – EHS – Recycling box request or indications

Be sure to include the number of bottles of Britz that you have for disposal in the Notes section of the request. The Luxottica EHS team will review your request and provide instruction.
